


The newest member of the mascot crew is full of energy. Her manners are improving but she is still young and learning. She has mastered trail guiding and guest protection against all imaginary threats.







Evidence of pets will result in an additional cleaning fee





THE KITCHENS

When you just want to stay in

Our kitchenettes come equipped with a mini fridge (full size in Oasis), microwave, coffee maker, induction hotplate, charcoal grill as well as plates, cups, bowls, utensils and cookware. Please make sure to clean the grills and any dishes used. For issues regarding the induction cooktop, refer to the tips below.



Problem Solving Tips

- AFTER INSERTING THE PLUG INTO MAIN SUPPLY, THE CHILD LOCK WILL BE ACTIVATED. PRESS AND HOLD THE CHILD LOCK KEY FOR 3 SECONDS TO DEACTIVATE.
- PLACE COOKWARE ON THE COOKING SURFACE BEFORE POWERING ON.
- E2 ERROR: COOKWARE IS EMPTY AT TOO HIGH A TEMPERATURE. AIR INLET/OUTLET IS BLOCKED. SURROUNDING TEMPERATURE IS TOO HIGH. TURN OFF AND RESET AFTER 5 MINUTES.
- E6 ERROR: COOKING TEMPERATURE IS TOO HIGH OR COOKWARE IS EMPTY. LET APPLIANCE COOL DOWN AND ADD PREVENT "DRY BOILING"




